Update of Pr. Tang's condition as of 1/14/25.

"Rejoice not over me, my enemy; Though I fall, I will rise; Though I sit in darkness, the Lord will be my light!" Micah 7:8

Praise the Lord, we are not afraid of being in the darkness since God is our light!

God listens to our prayers. Pr. Tang has a good medical team in the hospital. He takes a lot less medications and is in a much better condition. He doesn't vomit, has no bleeding and recovered from pneumonia, can digest his food without any problems, has since been weaned off from the ventilator. He can now breathe on his own with supplemental oxygen only. But he has a lot of phlegm.

#### Please pray:

- 1. For Pr. Tang,
  - A) He may be discharged soon. Pray that God will provide a bed in a quality subacute facility near home.
  - B) God will clear his phlegm, relax his muscles, reduce his stress, improve his immune system, strengthen his swallowing and coughing ability, and protect him from infections.
  - C) God will use massage, essential oils, acupuncture points, medications, and recorded voices to break through his condition.
- 2. For his father: He is having chronic pancreatitis. Pray that he will respond to the treatments and recover, and God continues to give him a peaceful heart, a good appetite, less pain, and strong faith.
- 3. For C-Mo: God gives her with a strong faith, restful sleeps, perseverance, and a good health.
- 4. God gives all 3 sons faith and good wholistic health.
