Roads are not always level and smooth, we need faith to walk on it to see God's grace and mercy!

Monday night Shalom and I were involved in a hit and run accident. All airbags were deployed and the car was totally damaged. By God's protection, both of us were not harmed.

Regarding Pr. Tang, we thank God that he responded well to the antibiotic treatment for his new aspiration pneumonia. His attending doctor said he would have less infections if he were awake.

Please pray that:

1. God makes him break through his brain damage to become conscious.
2. God uses his power through the essential oils and antibiotics to effectively eradicate his bacterial infections.
3. God strengthens him to fight off any fungal attacks.
4. God helps him regain his swallowing ability to avert aspiration pneumonia.
5. God uses the massage therapy to stimulate his blood circulation and nerve system. God will send more massage angels to stretch his curled up limbs.
6. For C-Mo, a CT scan at the emergency room after the car accident found out incidentally a mass in her right kidney. Follow-up work is needed to identify the nature of this mass. Pray that God will protect Mrs. Tang with strong faith, good sleeps and a great health, physically, emotionally, and spiritually.
7. God will strengthen all 3 sons with good physical. mental, and spiritual health.
